The 5 Basic Positions

The first 5 positions are the most important in the Akara Numerology System. They give you an immediate insight into someone's personality, talents, challenges, and goals. Let's take a closer look at each individual position and its meaning.

Soul

The Soul position represents your inner self. It is the moving force behind your personality, and is a part of your emotional makeup as well. This position is an important factor in how you make decisions in your life. When you want to understand what is truly important to someone, look to their Soul.

Mastery

The Mastery position is your homework assignment in this life! It represents an area of experience that you will be working on perfecting throughout your lifetime. An effort is required to manifest the Mastery in the Positive Pole. This is one of the calculations which connects you to other people. If your relationships are not working well, look to the Mastery position for the answer.

Gift

The Gift is your God-given ability and talent. It's what you're good at, and what comes naturally to you. When you're using your Gift wisely, other people will appreciate you for it. The "Attitude of Gratitude" will help you to maintain your Gift in its best possible light.

Knowledge

The Knowledge position is what you know. It is a body of wisdom or expertise which you have been working on for many lifetimes. Your archival memory bank of experience is contained here. It represents an area of knowledge in which you typically have a high degree of ability. This is one of the places to look when you want to know the inner language of a person.

Path

The Path is your fulfillment in life. This is where you will find the greatest joy, fulfillment, and expression of your Soul. It is an important position to look towards for long range planning and setting goals. Your Path will unfold more effortlessly when your Soul and Mastery are in the Positive Pole.

The 20th Century Rule

In most systems and structures, there are exceptions to the rule, and the 20th Century Rule is one of them. In this Century, whenever the Gift is a 10, the Knowledge is automatically an 11. This is to invoke a higher vibration.

Does this make the number 2 bad, or not good enough? No, not at all. The number 2 represents relationships. The number 11 represents the relationship between you and God, or you and your soul. Placing the number 11 in the Knowledge position means that you have been working on this higher octave relationship for many lifetimes. This encompasses the number 2.

The number 2 represents relationships, and on a higher spiritual level, it signifies a trustful and obedient relationship. This dynamic is realized in the number 11. Therefore, the 20th Century Rule is, "Whenever the Gift is a 10, the Knowledge is automatically an 11."

Chapter 6 Additional Calculations

Challenge

The Challenge is calculated by adding the Soul and Mastery numbers. This number is then reduced to a number from 1 to 11. Be aware of Significant Numbers, since they will give you more information about each position.

The Challenge calculation represents your ongoing learning challenge. It addresses an area that you will be dealing with in different ways throughout your life. If you have a 6 Challenge, it means that there will be times when issues surrounding your family life or schooling will arise. Your sense of personal security and protection may feel challenged. Typically, we gain a level of comfort in one area of our Challenge, and then something new will be experienced. This should not be judged as negative or bad, it is just part of life's learning process. It is so we may mature towards a more balanced and fulfilling life. It is important to look at the Transformer Number in the Challenge, since this gives you the extra information you need to help you deal with your challenges.

Projection

The Projection is the addition of the Soul and Gift. Our Projection is the frequency we emit or project to the world. This will affect how we are seen or perceived, and it will also effect what we attract to ourselves. This is very important, and when someone is asking, "why me?" one of the first places to look is the Projection. How well a person's Projection is working will often depend on how they are handling the vibration of their Soul. If it is in a Negative Pole, it will definitely throw off the Projection, even with the presence of the Gift in this calculation.

Chapter 3: Significant Numbers

Significant Numbers are a very important part of Akara Numerology: Significant Numbers are the higher octave of a reduced number. They have a greater story to tell in the interpretation of a person's characteristics. If someone is born on the 17th, we would say that they have a Soul of 8, but we would make a special note of the 17.

Significant Numbers are like the wide angle lens of a camera. They give you a wider scope of information and understanding. They help you to know the potential growth or challenges you will be facing throughout your life, Significant Numbers play an

important role in perceiving the real depth and dimension of a chart,

The following pages outline the Major Significant Numbers. It is important to become familiar with them, and to circle them when you are calculating the birthday in the Overview Table.

13) Ultimate Challenge - Ultimate Blessing

The number 13 is considered one of the Christ numbers. It imposes extra challenge and circumstances along a person's life path. It can represent deception and betrayal, and the literal analogy of Christ and his crucifixion is a perfect example of this. For Christ to become Christ, in order for him to achieve the exalted status he did, he had to be betrayed by Judas. Without the presence of Judas, Jesus never would have become the Christ.

The number 13 also represents the Power of the Word. What you say will happen. This can also be described as "Self-Fulfilling Prophecy." A person with one or more 13's in their chart would need to be aware of the power of their spoken word. It will manifest. This can be like a double-edged sword, and throughout a person's life they will have experienced both sides of his. Through conscious awareness this tool can be used for the better.

14) Physical Consequences

The number 14 represents physical consequences. It brings physical challenges that may or may not have an explanation, but must be dealt with anyway. It can manifest as a backache that never quite seem to go away, no matter how many doctors or therapies a person tries. An individual might be accident prone, or have some type of mental or emotional imbalance. The number 14 can manifest its influence in many ways, but typically will show up in some type of physical form, as the number 5 represents the physical body and physical world.

Historical Note:

1995 (9+5=14) was one of the most unusual years on a world scale for physical disasters. There were more hurricanes, floods, mudslides, explosions, accidents, etc., than what is normal. This is because of the presence of the number 14 in the yearly cycle.

16) Kindness and Forgiveness

The number 16 is one of the highest consciousness numbers. It represents kindness and forgiveness, and the presence of the number 16 will require a person to learn lessons surrounding forgiveness, thus the expansion of consciousness.

Seventeen is a lucky number! Whenever the number 17 appears in a person's chart, that person is considered lucky. There may be ups and downs as part of life's lessons, but a person will still receive what they need, just when they need it, because of the 17.

22) Master Planner

The number 22 represents someone who has good long range vision and planning ability.

It can also be a person with excellent managerial skills. Typically 22's are good with people, as the 22 is composed of two 2's. The number two represents relationships, and the number 4 represents structure, order and form.

In the Negative Pole, the 22 energy can be experienced as a person who is too caught up in the details of things. This can be someone who has possibly lost their long range vision, due to pickiness over the small things. Coming from the heart, and

keeping the welfare of others in mind, can help to change the perspective.

32) Ultimate Kindness and Compassion

The number 32 represents ultimate kindness and compassion. It is also considered one of the Christ numbers. Number 32 can also be seen as two 16s, but will need to manifest more through teaching and sacrifice. This is because the 32, reduces down to a 5. Communication, teaching, and selfless sacrifice are all part of the number 32.

33) Divine Sacrifice

When the number 33 appears in someone's chart, it signifies a higher calling in life. The person will be required to nurture, care for, or create (because of the double 3's), something of significance for humanity. This can also manifest on a more local level, as in the home (6 is the home). Family issues or loved ones may take more time and energy than you believe you have, thus the experience of sacrifice. Whether local or worldly, the number 33 will require a person to stretch and expand beyond their comfortable boundaries. Through this expansion can come a greater sense of Universal Love.
